

Student Learning Objectives (SLO)

All Highmore-Harrold teachers currently administer SLO assessments in their classes to measure student growth. SLO assessments are administered three times per school year: the first assessment establishes a baseline for student knowledge; assessments two and three measure student growth from the baseline. Teachers use the baseline data from their SLO assessments to determine a learning objective for their class to attain by the end of the school year. The Highmore-Harrold School District currently does not allow students to opt-out of student growth or diagnostic assessments.
